

General - You may use this calendar to help keep records required by your air quality permit.

Keep these records at your facility for 5 years.



SOLVENT RECOVERY DRYER: Petroleum solvent dry cleaning facilities installed after July 13, 1988, shall have a solvent recovery that recovers at least 85 percent of petroleum solvent by weight. In addition, the recovery cycle for the dryer shall not be terminated until the petroleum solvent flow rate from the water separator is 15 milliliters or less per minute. [County Rule 333 §302].
